#### III. Guaranteed Admission Program (Shiteiko Suisen)

Each designated junior high school is allocated one slot, and students must meet specific criteria, such as maintaining a certain grade point average (GPA) or higher. Students who apply through this program are guaranteed admission to our school and are also eligible for scholarships type A or type SA or type SS according to the score of the entrance examination.

- Scholarships will also be awarded to those who excel academically based on the results of the regular scholarship examination.

# Sports Scholars (Applicable to Athlete and Ballet Course Applicants)

- Please take the recommendation examination.
- Sports scholarships are categorized into A, B, and C. (For details, please refer to the section "Tuition Fees and Scholarship Systems and its Appendix A".)

\*Note: Scholarships cannot be combined.

# V. Types of Regular acceptance and the Rank-Up system by switching to the binding acceptance.

#### 1. Academic Scholarship Examination (regular application)

If a student (who passed the Academic scholarship Examination (regular application) enrolls on the 1st enrollment day, the following rank-up system will apply:

SA-type acceptance  $\rightarrow$  SS-type acceptance

(only if enrolled in the Special Advanced Course)

*A-type acceptance*  $\rightarrow$  *SA-type acceptance* 

(only if enrolled in the Special Advanced Course or Advanced Course)

*B-type acceptance*  $\rightarrow$  *A-type acceptance* 

*C-type acceptance*  $\rightarrow$  *B-type acceptance* 

D(C)-type acceptance  $\rightarrow$  C-type acceptance

E-type acceptance  $\rightarrow$  D-type acceptance

\*\* E-type acceptance applicants cannot enroll on the 2nd and 3d enrollment day.

# 2. General Scholarship Examination

If a student (who passed the General Scholarship Examination) enrolls on the 2nd enrollment day, the following Rank-up system will apply:

*B-type acceptance*  $\rightarrow$  *A-type acceptance* 

*C-type acceptance*  $\rightarrow$  *B-type acceptance* 

D(C)-type acceptance  $\rightarrow$  C-type acceptance

*E-type acceptance*  $\rightarrow$  *D-type acceptance* 

# VI. SS-type acceptance, SA-type acceptance and Prestige Scholars Funds (Gakushikin)

For Academic SS and SA-type Scholarship students, additional educational funds (Gakushikin or Prestige Scholars Funds) will be provided directly to parents.

For SS-type acceptance 300,000 yen per year For SA-type acceptance 180,000 yen per year

Note: SS-type Scholarship is for Special Advanced Course students, and SA-type Scholarship is for Special Advanced Course and Advanced Course students.

# VII. Alumni Family Scholarship (Oyako Kyodai Tokutai)

- 1. If any of the applicant's parents or siblings are graduates or current students of our school, half of the admission fee will be provided as a scholarship.
- 2. If twins enroll, half of the admission fee will be provided to each as a scholarship. (Note: Both 1 and 2 require procedures after enrollment. Academic and Sports Scholarship students are not eligible.)

# 2. Gunma Prefecture Admission Fee Support (Application Required After Enrollment)

Household income between 2.5 million yen and 3.5 million yen: 30,000 yen household income below 2.5 million yen: 60,000 yen

#### 3. Notes:

1. The actual income eligible for support may vary depending on the number of family members, their ages, and the number of working individuals.

- 2. Admission fees and other payments made at the time of enrollment are non-refundable.
- 3. Scholarship qualifications will be reviewed at the end of each academic year based on academic performance. The conditions for receiving scholarships may change based on the results of the review.
